We will walk downhill to the 17th century Portuguese Bridge. Here we can expect to see

plenty of birdlife including the Banded Barbet, the Black-Headed Forest Oriole, the White-

Billed Starling, the Red-Billed Starling, the White-Winged Cliff Chat, the White-Backed Black

Tit, White-Cheeked Turaco, and Hemprich's Hornbill. We will also see one of Ethiopia's

endemic mammals, the Gelada, or bleeding heart baboon.

In late afternoon, you may chose to relax at the beautiful resort in the spa, by the swimming

pool, or by having a relaxing massage. Or, if you feel energetic, take part in late afternoon

final training.
